

Bay Side Slide Terms & Conditions

GENERAL EVENT CONDITIONS

1. STABLING

The stalls at the Horse Park are Woodside at temporary 10' x 10' and do NOT include any pre-bedding. Stalls must be paid in full by **SUBMISSION/ENTRY** deadlines. Stalls are to be paid SEPERATELY from entries, checks made out to Brumley Management Group. \$15 late fee per stall will be added after deadlines. No stall refunds after deadlines. Feed and bedding orders can be placed through the Horse Park at Woodside, (650) 851-2140. No outside bedding allowed at the Horse Park. Haul-ins allowed at \$50 for entire event or \$25 per day.

2. **JUDGES** All decisions of the judges are final.

3. PHOTOGRAPHERS/VIDEOGRAPHERS

No outside video or photography is allowed. Competitors are encouraged to purchase videos and photos from the official show videographer and images from the official photographer. By way of entry into the event, competitors, and their respective employees, agents and family members grant the permission without remuneration for the use and public distribution of their image, likeness, voice and video for the possible promotion of the event. All exhibitors will be subject to the use of photographers and videographers under the direction of show management for the benefit of show promotion. No exhibitor will be allowed the discretionary use of his or her services. **ONLY THE OFFICIAL EVENT PHOTOGRAPHER WILL BE ALLOWED TO SELL PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE BAY SIDE SLIDE HORSE SHOW.** All images pertaining to or in relation to the Bay Side Slide are under the sole ownership of BMG, LLC. Only event management approved reporters assigned by recognized newspapers, radio or television or the Associated Press will be issued press passes. Requests for press passes **MUST** be sent in writing, faxed to 623-670-5905, or e-mailed to brumleymanagementgroup@gmail.com, on the stationery of the newspaper, magazine or broadcast outlet and signed by the editor. All other photographers must sign an agreement not to sell their photographs except to the publications for which they work two weeks prior to the beginning of the show. Photographers who have not followed these requirements will be escorted off the grounds.

4. DAMAGE

Individuals will be responsible for any physical damage inflicted to the Horse Park at Woodside property and will reimburse the show management for such damage as it may be charged. All owners and exhibitors shall be responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds and shall be billed accordingly.

5. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS & CERTIFICATES

Health requirements for the State of California and the Horse Park at Woodside will be followed. A 30-day health certificate and 12-month Coggins are required upon arrival for all horses coming from out of state.

6. LIABILITY

By participating in the Bay Side Slide, all competitors agree to abide by the rules of the show and the governing body NRHA. In addition, acknowledge that horses are dangerous animals and can be hazardous. By participating in the competition with this knowledge of the danger involved the competitor agrees to accept any and all risks of injury or death.

7. RULES/CHANGES

The Bay Side Slide and Brumley Management Group LLC, reserve the right to make additions or changes to this event at any time. Show management has the authority to enforce all rules referring to the show and may excuse any horse or exhibitor from the show prior to, during or after the judging without refunds. The show management reserves the right to interpret these rules and regulations. All decisions are final. By way of making an entry, the exhibitor is assuming responsibility for knowledge of the rules and releases show management from any claims or losses. The show management reserves the right to modify or change conditions for Bay Side Slide event at any time.

8. RIGHT TO CANCEL

The show management reserves the right to cancel the event without notice at any time prior to the contest and without liability to the show management. In the event of such cancellation, entry fees or other show fees paid in advance shall be refunded. The show management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to, the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by show management, its decision to be final. **SHOW MANAGEMENT RESERVES TO ITSELF THE RIGHT TO REFUSE, ACCEPT CONDITIONALLY, OR TO CANCEL ANY ENTRIES, DISQUALIFY ANY RIDERS OR EXHIBITORS, PROHIBIT EXHIBITION OF ENTRIES AND CANCEL AWARD PRIZES, WITHOUT CLAIM OF DAMAGES.** Every horse entered herein for competition will be under control of the show management, but the show management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show, officials, employees, Directors, Sponsors and the Horse Park at Woodside blameless for any loss or accident to horse(s), employees or equipment.

9. SECURITY AND PARKING

Neither Bay Side Slide/Brumley Management Group, LLC nor Horse Park at Woodside provide security prior to or during the event. Park in designated parking areas ONLY. Vehicles must display a VIP PARKING PASS to park in designated VIP Parking areas. Fines will be assessed for parking in or around the barn areas and no parking zones.

10. ANIMAL CONTROL

Dogs are to remain on a leash and must be kept under control at all times.

11. DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES

FAILURE TO PAY: Any fees associated with the entry of a horse in the Bay Side Slide, including but not limited to entry fees, administrative fees, stall fees, sponsorships, etc. which are not paid in full within 30 days of the close of the event will result in owner of horse or sponsor's immediate suspension from competing in or participating in any further Brumley Management Group, LLC events until amount owed and any late or NSF fees are paid in full.

BEHAVIOR, CONDUCT AND ANIMAL WELFARE: Any action of disrespect, deceit, slander or fraud directed to the event, show management, grounds crew, show representatives, sponsors or judges will result in disqualification from competition and removal from the facility. No entry, administrative fees or stall refunds will be provided. Individuals accused of unsportsmanlike conduct will be subject to the disciplinary procedures set forth by the National Reining Horse Association in Article A of the handbook. Anyone found to be abusing animals will be disqualified and reported to NRHA. **IN ADDITION, THESE INDIVIDUALS WILL BE SUSPENDED FROM PARTICIPATING IN ANY BRUMLEY MANAGEMENT GROUP, LLC EVENTS FOR A MINIMUM OF ONE YEAR.** Reinstatement of the right to exhibit is based on review by BMG production and show management.

ENTRY CONDITIONS

1. DIVISION ELIGIBILITY

ROOKIE ELIGIBILITY is an entry level III division.

For Non Pro, Youth, and Amateur riders with less than \$300 lifetime reining or reined cow horse earnings (from any and all shows, NOT limited to NRHA earnings) Riders must compete on a horse owned by them as defined in the NRHA handbook.

GREEN AS GRASS ELIGIBILITY is an entry-level II division.

For Non Pro, Youth, and Novice Amateur riders with less than \$100 lifetime reining or reined cow horse earnings (from any and all shows, NOT limited to NRHA earnings) who have earned less than 50 NRHA Youth points, and/or less than 20 AQHA or ANY Breed or Club Associated reining or reined cow horse points at the beginning of current show year. Class will be jackpotted. Green As Grass Reiner points will count toward year-end awards. An eligible Green As Grass Reiner can compete in the division for the entire calendar year even if their earnings exceed the limit during the year.

OTHER ANCILLARY DIVISIONS

Open, Non Pro, Youth, Rookie refer to the NRHA handbook for division eligibility.

2. FEES

Each horse entered in the event will be assessed a one-time Administration Fee of \$45, and \$5.00 California State Drug Fee. Exhibitors who do not check out their accounts prior to their departure will be charge a one-time fee of \$15 to close out their open check or credit card and mail receipt statement.

3. REFUNDS

Ancillary divisions will receive a refund of their entries if the divisions are scratched prior to the draw taking place. The Administration Fee of \$45 is non-refundable. Stalls are not refundable after submission deadlines.

4. SUBSTITUTIONS

Substitutions/transfers of entries will be permitted prior to the draws being posted, based on management's discretion.

5. DRAWS

In the instance where there is a group of classes of substantial size, management reserves the right to adjust the draw to allow riders with multiple entries the maximum number of horses possible between draw positions. This is to allow riders adequate time to prepare their horses in a safe and effective manner.

6. BAY SIDE SLIDE BUCKLE SERIES RULES

Bay Side Slide will hold four slates of competition offering exhibitors the chance to win series high point buckles, along with awards at each slate. In order to be eligible to win the high point buckles, exhibitors must show at a minimum of three out of four slates in the same divisions, same horse/same rider. Points are given based on division placement. For example; 1st place = 10 points, 2nd = 9 points, 3rd place = 8 points, etc. Ties receive the same number of points. High Point ties will be broken by a flip of a coin. High Point buckles will be awarded at the completion of slate #4, Sunday July 14, 2019.
